Assigning Roles

Assigning roles makes everyone comfortable with participating in the meeting and will help your meeting run more smoothly.

Moderator:

Kicks-off and keeps the meeting focused

Storyteller(s):

- Uses anecdotes to tell a positive Farm Credit story
- Farm Credit 101

Asker:

- Advocates for passing outstanding bipartisan Farm Bill provisions
- Asks for support of Farm Credit's priorities

Meeting Monitor:

 Ensures that primary objectives are met

Reporter:

Notes, follow-up

Responder:

- To criticism ONLY if asked
- Answers questions





A Few Reminders:

- Stay positive
- Localize, personalize, simplify
- Jargon doesn't work
- Focus on today and tomorrow
- It's not a conversation, it's a transaction
- Assign roles in advance
- Remember to listen
- Smile
